Happy New Year! We hope you had a lovely Christmas break.

Our first topic of the Spring term is Traditional Tales. During this time the children will learn a variety of well-known stories such as The Gingerbread Man, Little Red Riding Hood and Jack and the Beanstalk. We will act out the stories as a way to remember them, enjoy craft activities and PE sessions based on them, explore different ideas through Science investigations and have fun making up new versions of the stories. Our RE focus is Celebration, during which the children will learn more about celebrations that happen in church such as Mass and weddings.

Alongside your child's reading book, we will start sending home simple words that your child has been learning during phonics. Most of these will be sight words, meaning they can't be broken down to read and therefore need to be learnt through repetition and recognition. Practicing these will really help with fluency as your child starts to bring home books containing words.

This term our PE session will take place on a Wednesday morning. Please make sure your child has black shorts and a plain white t-shirt on this day every week.
