**Trinity Sunday.** Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. This is how our God has made Himself known to us. This is the God we believe in.

**Columban Mission Appeal.** We welcome Father John Collins, a priest of the Missionary Society of St. Columba. He will speak at all Masses this weekend, appealing for our support for the Society's work. The Columban Fathers were founded in Ireland in 1916 by two graduates of Maynooth National Seminary - Fr (later Bishop) Edward Galvin and Fr John Blowick. Our first mission was to China. The primary aim of the Columbans is inculturation of the Gospel in Cross Cultural environments. They engage in reconciliation, dialogue and building relationships between peoples of different faiths, cultures and ideologies. At the heart of their work is the call to help people become fully humane, to help establish a world of peace with justice and care for the integrity of creation in solidarity of the poor. In order to do so this effectively they strive to read the signs of the times through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, willing to take the risks of meeting the challenges that confront them. From the earliest years the Society of St Columban has had a strong presence in Britain, both in terms of Missionary vocations and material support. There are Columban Houses in London and Solihull (Birmingham).

**The Gift.** Six talks with discussions helping us go deeper into the Gift of the Holy Spirit. Led by Daniel Harris (Chaplain at St. Joseph's). Aimed at helping parishioners of all ages understand and live our Faith. Each Thursday 7pm (until 8.30pm) Banklands Hall. No meal with this course, but there will be refreshments . . . if you are good! See flyer at back of each church.

**First Holy Communion.** On the weekend of 17/18 June 22 children will be making their First Holy Communion at either St Gregory's or Our Lady & St Michael's.
